Robert was a fiend, painting away from 10 am till almost dark. Tracey spent the WHOLE day, 10 till almost dark in the kitchen.

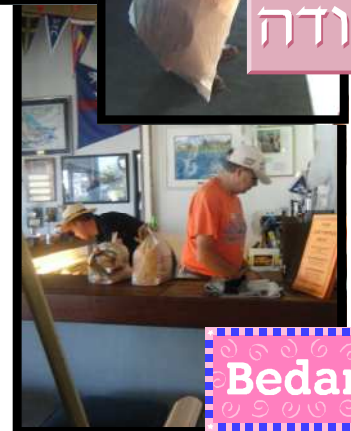
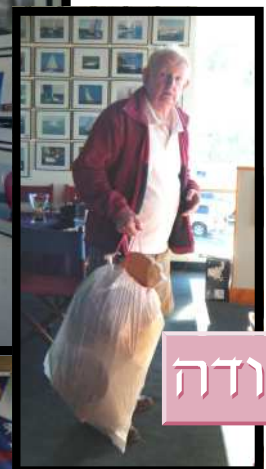
