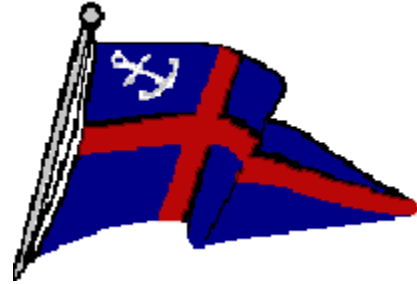


Notice of Race
One Design Weekend and
C15 North American Championship
July 23(C15 only), 24 , 25
Marina del Rey, CA



Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility: All One Design Boats, limited to 5 classes at the discretion of the Race Committee. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the fleet in which it competes.

Classes: C15, Schock 35, Martin 242, OPEN 5.70,. We invite one more class to join us. Any One Design Class is encouraged to have a representative contact Race Chairman, John Richardson at 323-640-4202.

Entries: Entries must be received by 9 AM, Friday July 23 rd for the C15s and Saturday, July 24 for other class. The Entry Fees are as follows.

Race entries may be completed on line at SCCYC.org or deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs or mailed to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC no later than 2000 hours on Thursday, July 22.

Starting Time & Expected Finish Time: On Friday, for the C15s only, the first race will start at 1200 hours, with the Warning Signal at 1155 hours. The RC will attempt to end racing at 5 PM. For all classes on Saturday and Sunday the first warning for the first class will be a 11:55. Saturday the RC will attempt to finish racing at 5PM, Sunday the RC will attempt to finish racing at 4 PM.

Courses: Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks. The course will be North of the Marina Del Rey Spar buoys. 3 races for the C15s on Friday, 3 or 4 races for all classes on Saturday and 2 or 3 races for all classes on Sunday. Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

C15 Scoring: On Friday for the C-15s only, the Syd Corp cup qualifying series of 3 races will be run with the first race starting at 13:00 hours. Based on the results from the qualifying series on Friday, "The split between the "A" Fleet and the "B" Fleet shall be made at the 1/2 point or a natural point within three boats of the 1/2 point. This shall be determined by the RACE COMMITTEE." (C15 NAC Policy 4a)

OD Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with one throw out, if 6 or more races are completed.

Penalties: Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.

C15 Trophies: The Coronado 15 Syd Corp Cup trophy will be awarded to the 1st place qualifier from the Friday races. 1st and 2nd place trophies will be awarded in both the A & B fleets will be awarded for the C15 North American Championship.

OD Trophies: Trophies for the Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Saturday, July 25th

Hospitality: Complimentary informal dinner for all racers as well as a no-host bar will be available at the SCCYC Club House following the racing. The Coronado 15 annual dinner and meeting will be held on Friday at the SCCYC Club house after racing.

Launching: At least one SCCYC Flag Member will be available each day to assist non members in using the hoist.

C15s racing in the North American Championship and/or qualifying series must be members of the C-15 Association. Membership application may be made via www.Coronado15.org or at SCCYC prior to boat measurement.

C15s racing in the North American Championship and/or qualifying series must meet the weight and measurement policies as specified in the By-laws on www.Coronado15.org.

Arrange for C-15 measurement by contacting John Richardson. Arrangements must be made before July 15th. Crew weigh in will be preformed Friday between 9:00 and 10:00 hours.
