

Notice of Race/Sailing Instruction

- 1. RULES:** This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Compliance with safety equipment is required for all yachts. Rule 44.2 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
- 2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Will be verbally announced at time of entry or prior to start.
- 3. ENTRIES:** Complete the attached entry form prior to 8:00 p.m. Saturday, 9/17, and deliver it to SCCYC or the designated Race Chair on Catalina Island, at the SCCYC BBQ.
- 4. CLASSES:** There will be one class. The Off Wind PHRF rating (current or manufacturer's), with cruiser offsets will be used. Cruising boats without a PHRF rating will be assigned a handicap by the Race Committee. Competitors choosing NOT to use a spinnaker will be given a spinnaker offset of 15 seconds per mile (+15) or their PHRF offset.
- 5. ELIGIBILITY:** Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing.
- 6. SCHEDULE:** The start is at 11:00 a.m., Sunday 9/18.
- 7. START:** The start will be a rabbit start.
- 8. COURSE:** The start will be in the vicinity of Ship Rock (approximately ¼ mile southwest of Ship Rick). The course is directly to 10PV Buoy, a red bell buoy (33° 46' 24.0" N, 118° 26' 41.8" W). Handicap distance is 18 nm.
- 9. FINISH:** The finish will be abeam the 10PV Buoy, holding it within 50 yards to starboard. Take your own GPS time and email your completed finish form to the PRO at portcaptain@sccyc.org no later than 8 pm Sunday 9/18.
- 10. TIME LIMIT:** Qualifiers must finish before 4:00 p.m. Sunday September 18th.
- 11. PROTESTS:** Protests must be filed with the race committee at SCCYC by 7:30 p.m. immediately following the race.
- 12. RADIO COMMUNICATION:** The Race Committee will monitor VHF channel 71.
- 13. SCORING:** Corrected time will be used to determine the finish order.
- 14. PRIZES:** The first-place winner will be added to the perpetual trophy.
- 15. HOSPITALITY:** Saturday night, a happy hour reception (starting around 4:00pm) will be held on the PRO's boat, with dinner at Harbor Reef to follow. Mooring location to be confirmed, email or text PRO for location.
